### Digibet chooses Net Entertainment's award winning platform

**Betsson's fully owned subsidiary Net Entertainment has signed a contract with Digibet (former wetten.de) to deliver the award winning platform CasinoModule™.**

At the end of September Net Entertainment signed the contract with Betclick, an English based betting site with 230,000 registered users, for the delivery of the platform CasinoModule™. As early as last week, after only 31 calendar days, Betclick's casino went live.
